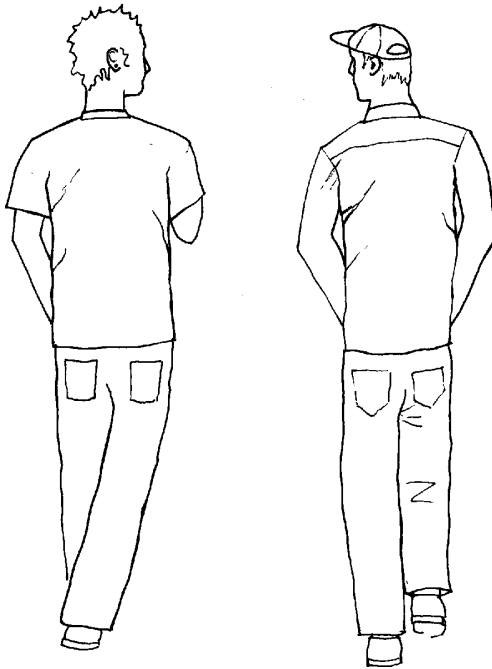

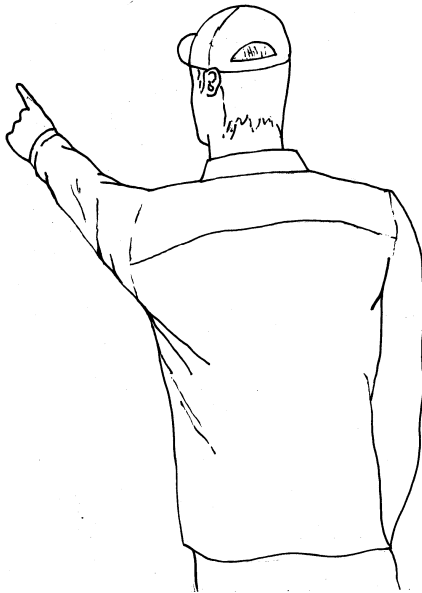

See that man."



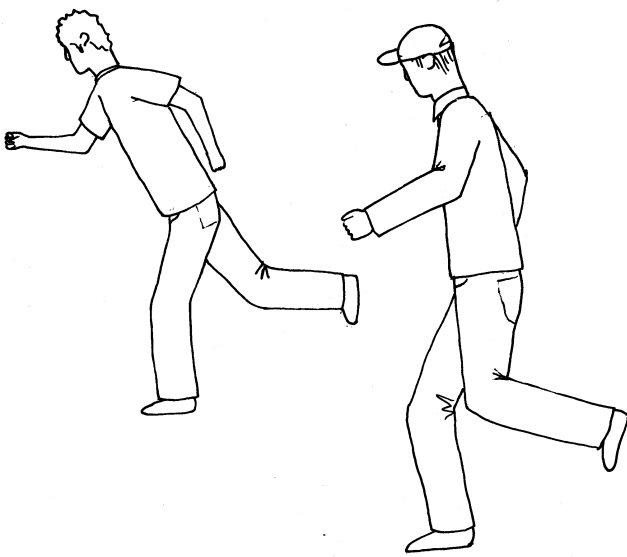
They saw a robber standing by a jewellery shop. He had a brick in his hand. The robber wore a striped jumper and a cap.



Brian and Simon saw him throwing the brick at the jewellery shop window. The window broke into bits. The robber took watches from the shop.



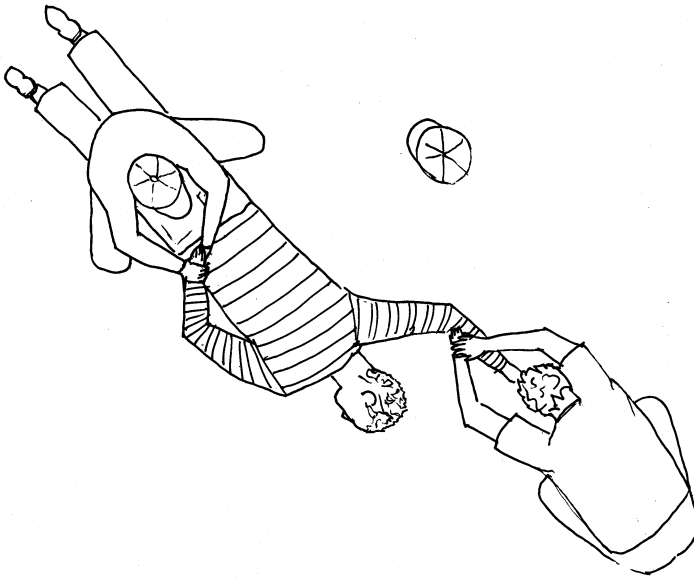
Brian said, "Simon, let's stop him!"
Simon said, "Yes, let's run."



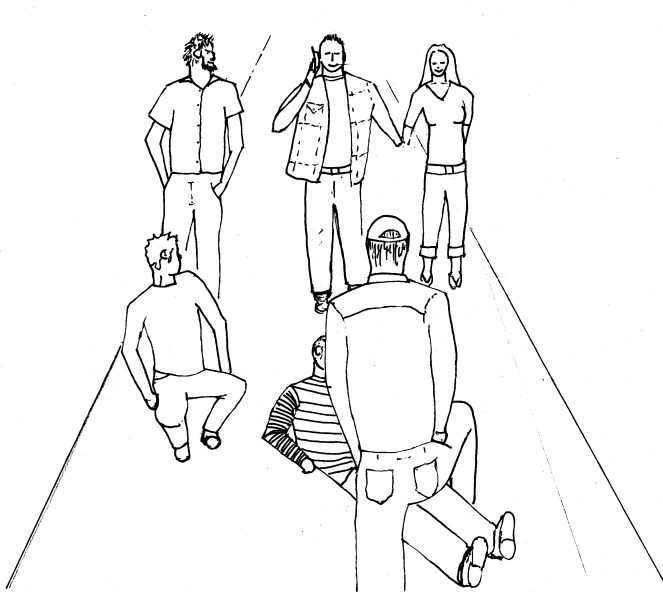
They ran after the robber. The robber was shocked. He ran away. He dropped the brick and the watches.



Brian and Simon jumped on the robber. His cap fell away from his head. Brian grabbed the robber's hair. Simon held to his arm. The robber looked hurt.



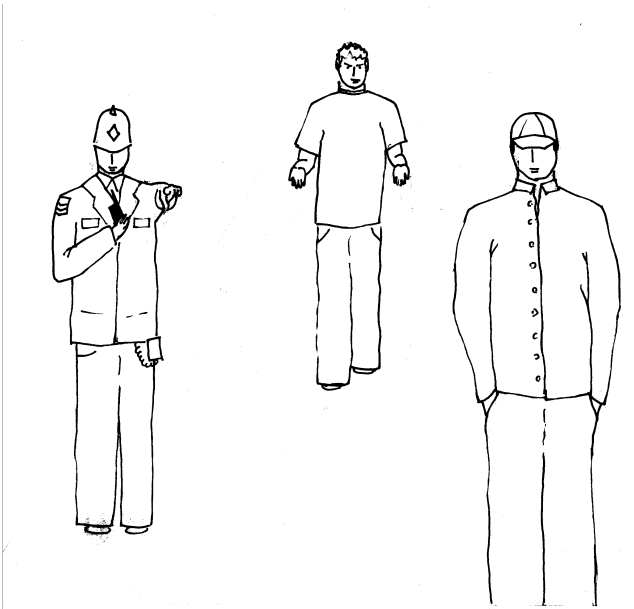
Suddenly, the boys heard people laughing. A woman and two men were laughing. Simon and Brian were puzzled and let the robber go.



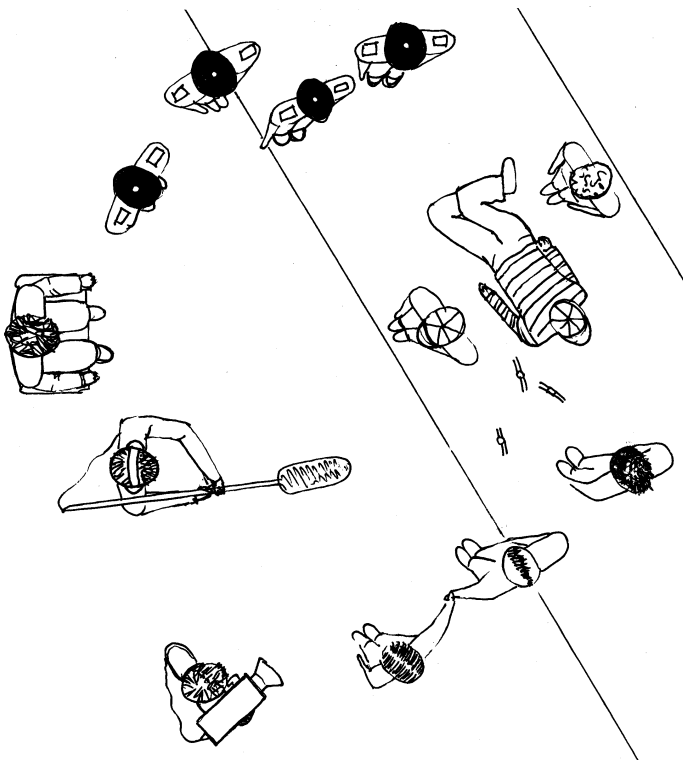
A policeman came to them and told them off.

Double Click



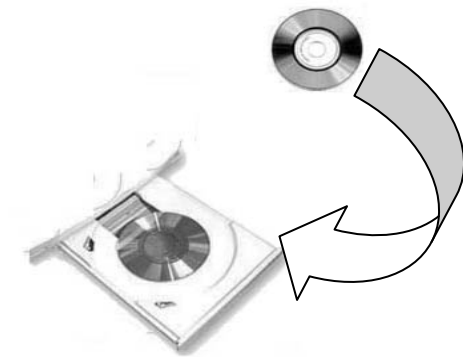
