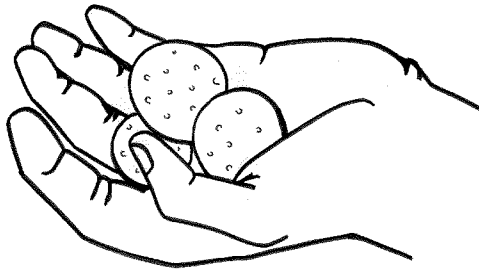
Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) loved being with children so much.

He gave the season's new fruits to the youngest children.



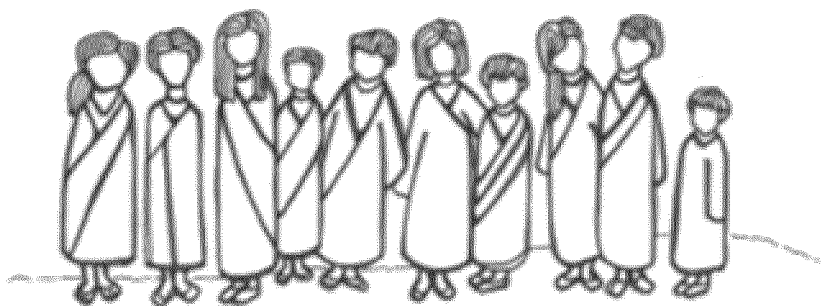
Nearby, a Bedouin saw how the children were so happy with the Prophet. He saw the Prophet talking to them, patting their heads and kissing them all.

"How can I help you if Allah has taken away all the love from your heart?" said the Prophet.

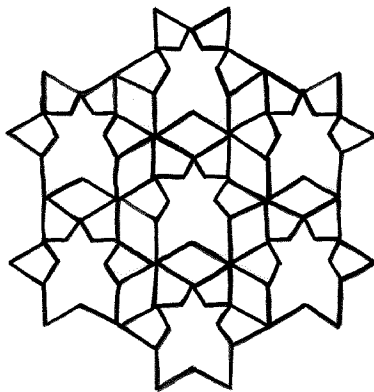
The Bedouin felt even sadder.

*My Computer*

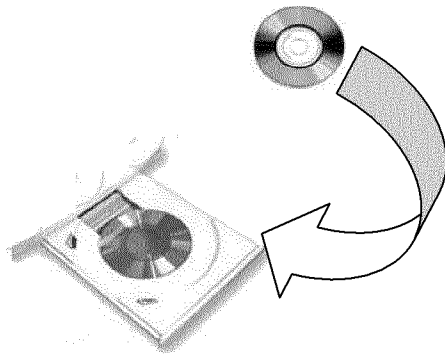
Double Click

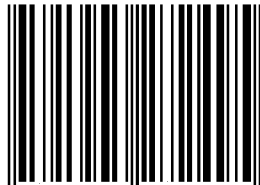
