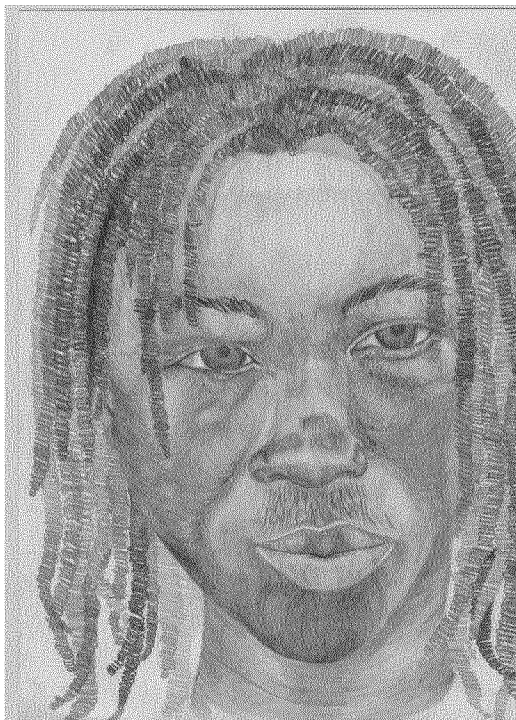

Double Click



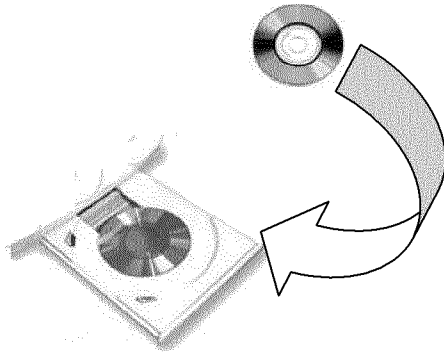
