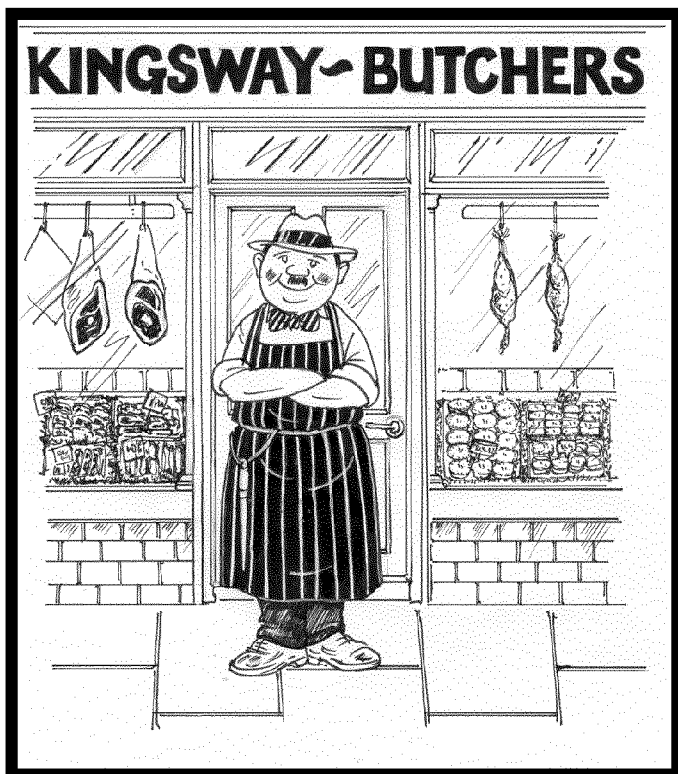

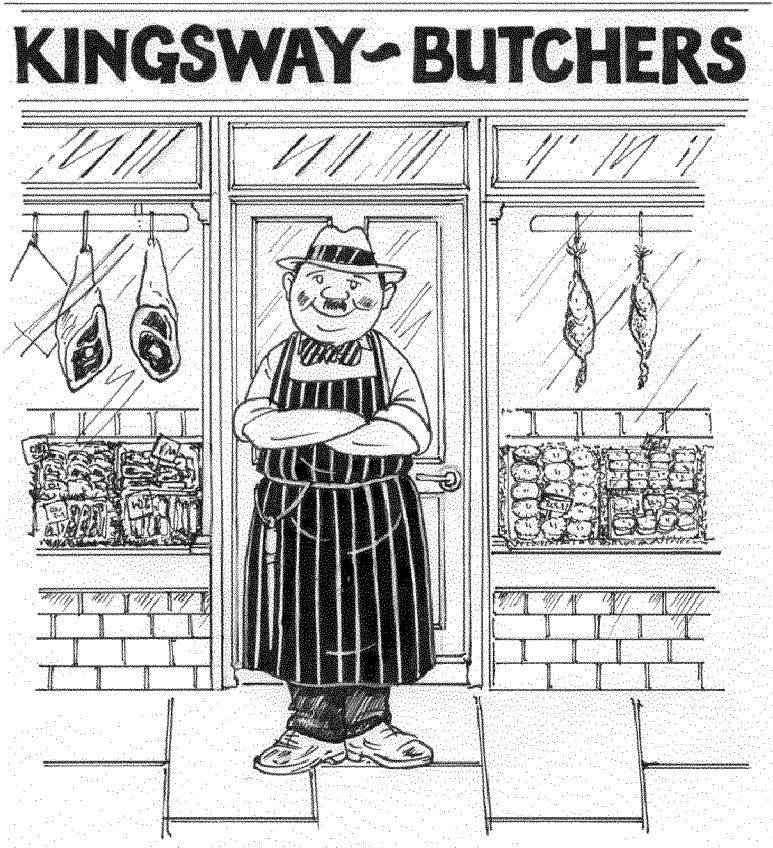

Mr. Jones has an assistant. His name is Paul Clark. He is 18 and he came straight from school.



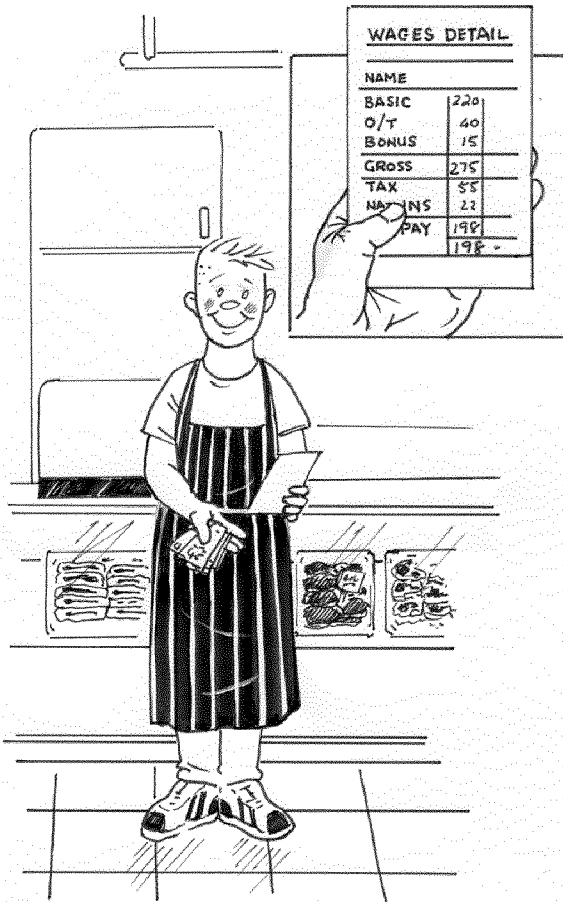
Mr. Jones is very proud of his shop. In 1966, he opened the shop. He is still working!

Double Click



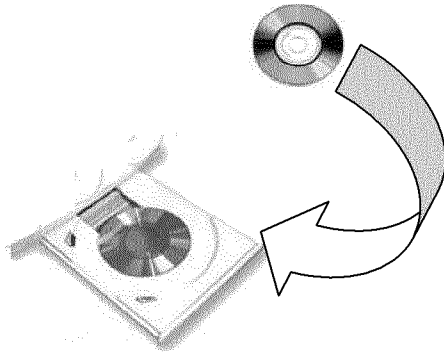
